**FIREARMS ACT 1968 (AS AMENDED):
AUTHORITY OF THE SECRETARY OF STATE UNDER SECTION 5**

I am directed by the Secretary of State to say that, under section 5 of the Firearms Act 1968 (as amended), she hereby authorises you to have in your possession, to purchase, acquire, sell and transfer, in the course of your business as manufacturers of rocket launcher pods on behalf of Roxel (UK Rocket Motors) Limited, no more than twelve prohibited weapons to which section 5 (1)(ae) of the Firearms Act 1968 (as amended) applies at any one time.

Prohibited weapons for which an authority of the Secretary of State is required must **not** be sold or transferred to any person who does not hold an authority of the Secretary of State under section 5 unless that person is exempt from the need to hold an authority by virtue of the Act.

This authority is valid until **31 August 2019** and is given on the following conditions that:-

1. the prohibited weapons are stored at no place other than the company premises at Coventry Road, Exhall, Coventry, CV7 9FT under secure conditions as agreed with and satisfactory to the chief officer of Warwickshire Police.
2. the prohibited weapons are transported under secure conditions as agreed with and satisfactory to the chief officer of Warwickshire Police or, alternatively, using only those carriers who hold an appropriate authority under section 5 of the Firearms Act 1968 (as amended);
3. the chief officer of Warwickshire Police and the Home Office, Drugs & Firearms Licensing Unit, Firearms Section are notified **in advance** of any change of company

name, company address, named authority holder, or change of procedure for the safekeeping of prohibited weapons;

4. **Mr Stefan Wieszak** ensures that all reasonable precautions are taken to secure the safe custody of the prohibited weapons and that proper records of **all** transactions involving the prohibited weapons are kept; and
5. this authority shall no longer be valid if **Mr Stefan Wieszak** ceases to hold office with Nasmyth Technologies Limited.

This authority does not exempt you from the need to comply with the requirements of the Firearms Act 1968 (as amended). In addition, you must be registered with your local police as a firearms dealer.

Under section 5(5) of the Firearms Act 1968, it is an offence for a person to whom an authority is given under this section to fail to comply with any condition of the authority.

Under section 5(6) of the Firearms Act 1968, the Secretary of State is empowered to revoke this authority at any time.
